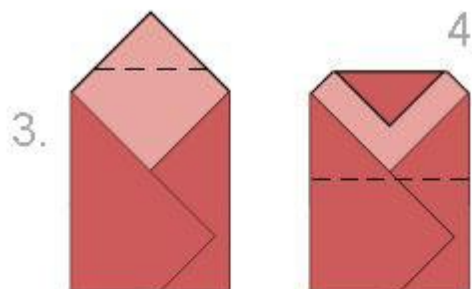
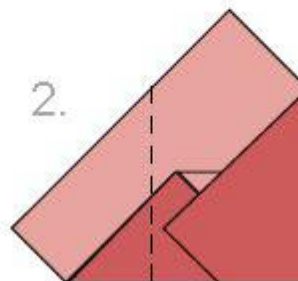
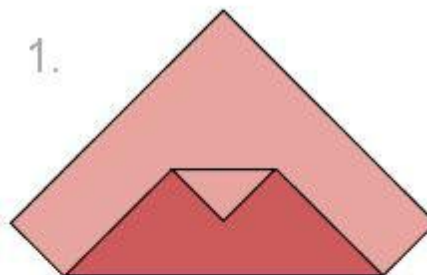


Stampin' Up!®s Country Living Cookout Kit – Paper-Folding Tips

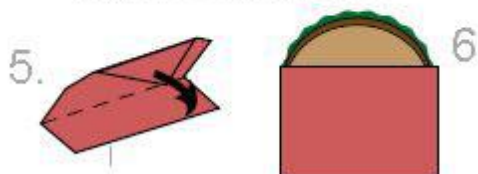

Burger or Sandwich Wrap

1. Fold full sheet of waxed sandwich wrap paper according to diagram; dark part of image is right side of paper
2. Fold right section towards left at approximately the 1/3 point, keeping bottom edges even. (Note: the farther over you fold it, the shorter the resulting pocket will be from left to right – so if you have very large burgers or sandwiches, you may prefer to not fold as much over towards the left.)
3. Fold the left side over equal distance as you folded the right side, matching bottom edges. Note where the top point will be folded down.
4. Fold down the top point; then fold the resulting piece in half from top to bottom.
5. As you fold the wrapper in half (in step 4), pull out the top triangle created at the beginning of step 4 and tuck it inside the pocket. If you prefer, you may use a little bit of SNAIL in strategic areas to hold the wrapper together and to make a sturdier pocket.
6. Slip burger inside and enjoy!
